



Advising Work Load Sidebar

In the Fall of 2018, the University implemented NEST. The RFF has raised concerns related to the impact of NEST on its members' advising work load and on the evaluation of the members' advising. The NEST system allows the University to gather data related to such potential impacts.

The University agrees to provide training on the NEST system during its Fall 2019 Faculty workshops. The University will refrain from evaluating and measuring faculty usage of the Nest until completion of this training. The University further agrees to meet and confer with the RFF in the Spring of 2020 to review the implementation of NEST and to discuss potential modifications to the NEST system and University monitoring of faculty involvement with the system.
