### Campus Parking

- ❖ All members of the FPU community are required to register vehicles with the Department of Campus Safety and display a valid parking decal or permit on the vehicle.

### FP Alerts

- ❖ FP Alerts is a mass notification system that enables University students, faculty and staff to receive alerts and updates as text messages on cell phones. Participation by the University community is voluntary.
